

JRA Participant Code of Conduct

- Obey all rules established by the JRA Board and Advisors and all local, state and federal laws.
- Be respectful and courteous of all people at all times.
- Participants are expected to attend all sessions as part of a planned program exhibiting positive character and behavior.
- Participants are expected to be responsive to the reasonable requests of the staff, board, and chaperones and be
 respectful of the needs for their personal safety and the safety of others.
- Refrain from loud, unruly talking; vulgar language; swearing; and other unbecoming conduct.
- Dress appropriately for the occasion and event, as deemed by event organizers.
- Participants may not use alcohol, drugs, or tobacco, nor be associated with or remain in the presence of others using the substances.
- Participants may not behave recklessly, engage in sexual misconduct, assault, threaten, or harm another person nor may they misuse or abuse public or private property.
- Respect the property and the facilities being used for an event and only use the facilities, buildings or other places deemed acceptable while at the event. Avoid places or activities that in any way could raise questions as to ones safety, moral character or conduct.
- Participants are not permitted to leave the program area unless approved by the RAAA staff member and the participant is accompanied by a chaperone.
- The operation of a motor vehicle by a participant is prohibited while attending and participating in the program. Vehicles used to arrive at the program shall remain parked at the departure hotel until the conclusion of the program.
- Misuse or damage to any property is prohibited. Charges will be assessed against those participants who are responsible for damage or misuse of property.
- Represent the Junior Red Angus Association, the Red Angus breed, the beef industry and the agriculture industry with pride.

While attending JRA overnight events:

- Be courteous to the other guests and remain quiet in the hallways.
- Follow announced curfew times. A room check will be done to account for all participants.
- I will remain in my designated room and not enter other sleeping areas after curfew.
- I will not invite non-JRA members to enter sleeping areas at any time.

Realizing these guidelines are not "all-inclusive" the Red Angus Association Staff reserves the right to make adjustments to these policies.

Consequences of breaking the JRA Code of Conduct and any additional rules set forth at any JRA-sponsored event may include, but are not limited to, being sent home immediately and at the expense of the member as well as not being allowed to participate in future JRA-sponsored events and/or shows. JRA advisors have authority to determine consequences for conduct (listed and non-listed) deemed unacceptable
